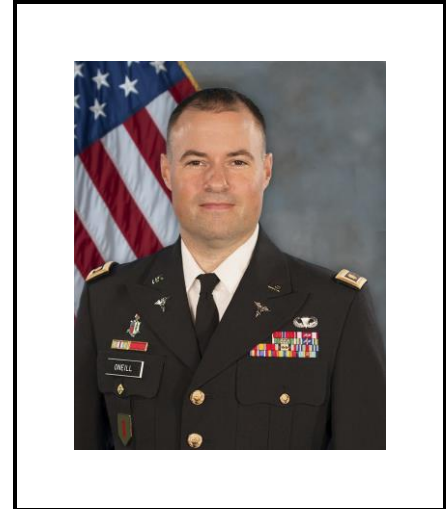


LTC Daniel J. O'Neill

LTC Daniel O'Neill was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant in the Medical Service Corps in 2002 after graduating from St. John's University Collegeville, MN with a BA in Biology. After completing OBC, he was assigned as a Platoon Leader with B Co. 226th Medical Logistics Battalion, Misseau, Germany. He deployed to Iraq serving as OIC of the Forward Distribution Teams from Jan 2004 to Jan 2005. Upon return, he was assigned as the Division Medical Supply Officer, 701st Main Support Battalion, 1st Infantry Division, Kitzgen, Germany. After their deactivation, he was assigned to C Co. 299th FSB 2nd BCT 1st Infantry Division, Schwienfurt, Germany deploying to Iraq from Aug. 2006 to Nov 2007 serving as the OIC for detention operations, Brigade Medical Supply Officer and finally as the Deputy SPO. Upon return, LTC O'Neill attended the Captains Career Course. After graduation, he was assigned as the Chief of Materiel, Tripler Army Medical Center, Hawaii then as the Chief of Logistics and Company Commander at the Schofield Barracks Health Clinic. He then was selected for the MBA School of Choice program and attended the University of Minnesota receiving his MBA in Supply Chain Management in 2015. He then served as the Chief of Requirements and Programs for the Office of the Surgeon General G-46 at Ft. Detrick, MD. LTC O'Neill was then assigned to the United States Army Medical Materiel Agency and served as the Chief of Materiel Fielding followed by the Director of the Force Sustainment Division and finally as the Deputy Commander for Operations.



His military education included the AMEDD Officers Basic Course, Health Services Materiel Officers Course, AMEDD Officers Advanced Course, Hospital Medical Logistics Course, Health Systems Functional Proponent Course, the Command and General Staff Officer Course and the Battalion Pre-Command Course. He has also completed the Army Lean Six Sigma Green and Black Belt programs and is Defense Acquisition University certified Level 1 in Life Cycle Logistics and Level 3 in Program Management.
